

electing course reps



- We are suggesting that in order to remove barriers for students, Course Rep elections are no longer necessary, and any keen student should be allowed to be a rep.
- However, if PL's feel elections are appropriate for their cohort, they should feel free to continue as they wish.
- Where possible there should be a minimum of two Course Reps per programme, per stage. However, unlike previous years, there is not an upper limit on the number of Course Reps.
- Course Reps may hold the post for more than one year but must express renewed interest for each cohort stage.
- Any <u>returning</u> Course Rep information should be shared with the Student Voice Team during Semester 2 for the following year. First year and Postgraduate selection must take place in September.
- The process is usually facilitated by the Programme Lead.



electing course reps



- Moving forward, Programme Leads should encourage all students who are interested in becoming a Course Rep to put their name forward. At the discretion of the PL, a statement of interest may be requested but is not necessary.
- We do not anticipate that there will be too many reps but rather removing the in-person election aspect will reduce barriers for those wanting to get involved.
- PL's may wish to consider encouraging students from certain underrepresented demographics to put themselves forward e.g. mature students, international students.
